Strategy

With active central banks, currency fluctuations are very prevalent in today's market. These fluctuations can lead international investors to take on additional currency risk—the potential for diminished returns as foreign currencies move against the U.S. dollar. Xtrackers MSCI Eurozone Hedged Equity ETF (DBEZ) seeks investment results that correspond generally to the performance, before fees and expenses, of the MSCI EMU IMI U.S. Dollar Hedged Index, which seeks access to Eurozone equities while potentially mitigating against currency fluctuations between the U.S. dollar and the euro.


