



American Jobs Creation Act Qualified Interest Income (QII) Percentages for the Xtrackers Funds (2017)

Non-Resident Alien (“NRA”) shareholders are normally subject to a 30% (or lower tax treaty rate depending on the country) NRA withholding tax on ETF dividend income and short-term capital gain dividends paid by a mutual fund, unless such dividends are designated as exempt from NRA withholding tax.
